WHAT WILL BE SHOWN?

- Works must relate to the theme **Neighbourhood**.
The way in which 'neighbourhood' inspires the work is left to the discretion of the artist and could be expressed in terms of subject, technique, imagery, social issues etc.
- Each submission must be an original work which includes a hand printed element.
- One submission may consist of several related items, such as a triptych or series, provided that the items are intended to be sold as a single work.
- Large works or a second work from a participant are welcome - dependent on available space. Any work larger than 900 x 900 cm wall space or 750 x 750 x 750 cm (3-D works) will require prior approval from the organising committee to ensure there is sufficient space.
- Work may be displayed framed or unframed. Some frames are available for hire from CPI. Unframed works on paper will be displayed using magnets supplied by CPI.
- Any questions about suitability, appropriate fees etc, should be directed to the Exhibition Committee as early as possible.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Printmakers from central Queensland and invited printmaking groups may participate.
- Artists do not need to be a member of Capricornia Printmakers Inc. to participate. Please feel free to forward to anyone you think may be interested in joining CPI or participating in this exciting exhibition.
- We welcome teachers to encourage senior art students who work to a professional standard to participate

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The work entered must be the work of the submitting artist, completed within 12 months of the exhibition and not previously exhibited.
- All works should be signed, dated and titled to CPI standards.
- All works should be accompanied by a Certificate of Authenticity which includes information about materials used.
- The exhibited artwork must be available for sale. 30% commission applies: 10% of which is paid to Rockhampton Regional Council and 20% is retained by CPI.
- Whilst only one artwork will be exhibited per submission, opportunities will be available for the sale of additional editions of the work in the CPI 'pop-up' shop. Care should be taken to price additional editions in line with the Exhibition work.
- Art works will be exhibited at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee.
- An additional opportunity for sales will be available in a 'pop up' shop in the Capricornia Printmakers studio at 10% commission.
- Information about artists and their work will be requested for marketing prior to the exhibition. Details will be emailed in due course.

PARTICIPATION FEES

For one submitted work (or series of related works):

- \$50 for CPI members
- \$65 for non-members
- \$30 for secondary school students
- Additional works by an exhibiting artist: \$20 per work

NOTE: Exhibition fee does not include CPI membership or studio fees. New members are always welcome, and annual fees are \$50.00 per year.

YOUR ASSISTANCE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR THE EXHIBITION

CPI members will be required to help with the organisation and preparations for this exhibition. Volunteers will be required for online and print promotions, preparation and catering for the opening night, installation of the works, cleaning the studio, etc. A list of tasks will be circulated.

Exhibitors will also be on a roster to staff the exhibition during its run.

Exhibitors who are not CPI members are not required to volunteer, although they are most welcome to participate in all activities.
