Materials

- Bring your own paper to create these five sample books. Papers can be A4 or A3 size or larger, suitable papers are cartridge paper, printmakers paper, photocopy paper, your imperfect prints. Cartridge and printmaking papers are available to purchase at cost price in the studio. **You will need 10 – 12 sheets of A3 paper, larger sheets can be cut down, if bringing only A4 and A3 some joining will be required.**
- Small amount of pva glue

Tools

All tools are provided, however, please feel free to bring your own if you would like to use them.

- Bone folder/paper folder
- Awl
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Stanley knife
- Steel ruler
- Glue brush and water container
- Pencil
- Embroidery needle (blunt end with big eye)
